

# Rushford Free Library 2022 Report to the Community

## A look back on 2022:

- 16,022 total holding at the library (books, dvd, magazines, etc.)
- 34,229 electronic materials available thru STLS
- 4,233 circulation at the library
- 574 registered borrowers
- 96 memorials given
- 437 new items added to holding this year
- 3,151 patrons visited the library
- 109 programs with 1,203 attending. (this is onsite and offsite programs)

### On-going programs at the library are:

- ◆ Preschool programs are held on Friday mornings at 10:00 am. Bring your littles for a fun time of story-reading, crafts and snacks.
- ◆ The Needler's meet every 1st. 2nd. & 4th. Tuesday afternoon at 1:30 pm. for a time of visiting and working on personal project. All are welcome to come and join them.

- ◆ Summer program theme this year is "All Together Now." Books and crafts have been purchased for our July - August in-house programs. School age children will meet on Thursday afternoons at 1:30 pm. and pre-school will meet on Friday mornings at 10:00 am.
